Notable Events in the History of Macaroni and Cheese











1770s

The first known modern written recipe for macaroni and cheese appears in *The* **Experienced English** Housekeeper, by a Mrs. Elizabeth Raffald.

1802

Macaroni and cheese comes to America. Having encountered the dish in Europe, America's third president, Thomas Jefferson, imports pasta and Parmesan cheese for use at Monticello and serves his version of "a pie called macaroni" at a state dinner in the U.S.

1937

Kraft Macaroni & Cheese dinner is introduced in the U.S. and Canada. Kraft Macaroni & Cheese remains the #1 brand in the U.S. in a popular category. More than a million boxes of Kraft Macaroni & Cheese are sold each day.

1993

Fun Facts About Mac & Cheese **Eating Occasions**

- Mac & cheese eating occasions skew to youth. More than half (53%) of macaroni and cheese eating occasions involve Millennials, compared to just 19% involving Baby Boomers.
- Mac & cheese is eaten for breakfast. About one in ten (12%) of macaroni and cheese eating occasions occurs as breakfast, while another 12% occur as an early morning snack before breakfast.
- Mac & cheese is a social thing. About one-third $(\mathbf{30}\%)$ of macaroni and cheese eating occasions are with family, while another 16%involve eating with friends.
